
Dear Dr. Schmon,

The Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (Air District) has had the opportunity to review your submitted documents and request for approval of the sale and usage of the SATAjet 100 B F RP, SATAjet 100 BP and SATAjet 1000 B RP spray guns in the County of Imperial. In going over the documents, the Air District agrees with South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD) conclusion that the transfer efficiency tests performed demonstrate that the aforementioned spray guns are capable of achieving equivalent of better transfer efficiencies than high-volume, low-pressure spray equipment. Therefore, the SATAjet 100 B F RP, SATAjet 100 BP and SATAjet 1000 B RP spray guns are approved for sale and use in the County of Imperial, subject to the requirements of Air District Rule 427 – Automotive Refinishing Operations.

Furthermore, the sale and usage of the spray guns in question within the County of Imperial must adhere to all seven of the equipment, performance, notification, and labeling conditions set by the SCAQMD in their Equipment Approval letters dated August 14, 2012. Failure to meet any one of these conditions will result in the equipment being deemed non-compliant and subject to action by the Air District's Enforcement Division.
