APPROVAL OF SATAMINIJET4400B RP SPRAY GUNS WITHIN THE SHASTA COUNTY AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

In response to an e-mail dated March 6, 2017, from Suzanne Walters, regarding approval of the above-subject spray gun, the Shasta County Air Quality Management District offers the following as official approval.

Please be advised that the Shasta County Air Quality Management District will authorize the use of any spray-coating equipment that can demonstrate at least 65 percent transfer efficiency under the conditions of its use. The material from the South Coast Air Quality Management District, which you provided with your letter, indicates that your spray guns are capable of meeting this standard. Therefore, the Shasta County Air Quality Management District will authorize the use of the subject SATAminijet 4400 B RP in Shasta County subject to the same conditions as those mentioned by the South Coast Air Quality Management District in their letter dated October 16, 2015.
